

# Teenweath.org Poster Information and Instructions

Suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death for youth ages 12-18 (2016 CDC). More teenagers and young adults die from suicide than from cancer, heart disease, AIDS, birth defects, stroke, pneumonia, influenza, and chronic lung disease, **COMBINED** (Jason Foundation).

Teens always have their phones and will not look for help like adults do. Teens in distress can scan the QR code from the cell phone camera app and click the Teenweath.org popup with access to autodial hotline/textline icons, then hit send/ok to connect to free, anonymous help.

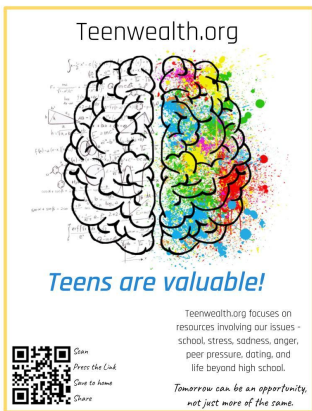
**Goal for Teenweath.org:** Place small poster (8 ½ x 11”) in every high school and middle school student restroom. Why restrooms? Because that is where most of the vaping, drugs, bullying, and peer pressure is taking place.

## Suggested places for posters:

1. Student restrooms: interior side of each toilet stall door.
2. Counselor's office
3. Nurse's office
4. Library
5. Activity or Multi-purpose room

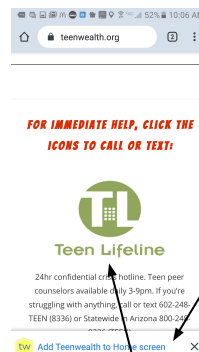
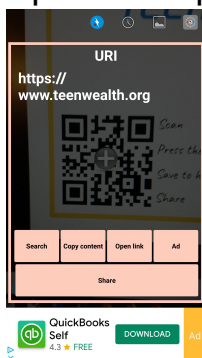


## Access Teenweath.org from internet browser or QR Code. QR code instructions:

1. Using mobile phone camera, hover over QR code. Some phones require a QR code reader app.

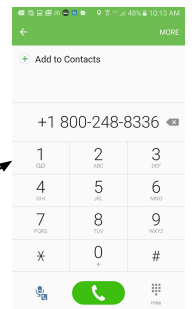


2. Click website link popup. (wifi or data required to open)



3. Add to home screen by pressing popup. (varies by phone)
